

on its records and those of its municipalities, recipients of Material Aid and their dependents in such manner as will facilitate the National Registration of persons in receipt of said Aid, especially as to their degree of employability as provided in Appendix "A" attached to and forming part of this Agreement; and the Province further undertakes on its own behalf and on behalf of its municipalities to furnish promptly to the Dominion such reports as may be required each month to maintain the National Registration of persons in receipt of aid, whether material or agricultural, to which the Government of the Province contributes financially.

4. The Province agrees to exclude from the payment of Material Aid to which the Dominion contributes pursuant to this Agreement, the municipalities or districts in which the need arising from unemployment, loss of occupation, or agricultural distress is and continues negligible and to report to the Dominion, from time to time, the name of the municipalities or districts so excluded.

5. The Province agrees to maintain such residence regulations that no person shall become ineligible to receive Material Aid by reason of having lost residence in one municipality or jurisdiction within the Province before having established residence in another and to require from all applicants for said Aid resident in districts in which there is an office or representative of the Employment Service of Canada (other than resident farm operators and those engaged in farm work) proof of application by them to the said Service for work, of determination by said Service of their employability and of periodic registrations of them by said Service as conditions precedent to the granting of said Aid.
