
SIR,-

In accordance with an application from Mr. J.S. Dennis, Can. Pacific Railway, Calgary Alberta, permission has been given to the said Company to have necessary surveys made in the Blackfoot Indian Reserve in connection with a large irrigation project in hand. The Company is to pay for damages, if any, that may be caused in the execution of the surveys and no work of construction is to be proceeded with until the Right of way has been duly arranged for with this Department.

Mr. Agent Gooderham has been instructed to inform the Indians and also to instruct them not to molest the surveyors in the execution of their work.

If you have any further communications to make to Mr. Gooderham on the subject, I shall be obliged if you will kindly make them.
