



Ottawa, 12th July, 1905.

Rev. Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 5th instant, I beg to inform you that the Department will accept Mr. Donald Campbell's receipt for the cheque sent you for repairs to roads on the Whyccomagh Reserve. The cheque, however, should not be handed to Mr. Campbell until he has signed the certificate at the foot of the return for labor performed and also made the said return in duplicate. The account for planks, nails, &c. should be certified by some ~~person~~ person other than Mr. Campbell. The return and account for lumber &c. are returned herewith for amendment in these particulars.
