Sir-

I beg to transmit herewith cheque No. 301 for \$2.55 being balance due you in connection with your account for articles supplied for use of the teacher at the St. Isidore Road School, Ojibawaga Reserve. Your account rendered at \$12.54 was received from Mr. Letourneau. It has been reduced by \$9.99 as the articles which were supplied to the teacher, Miss Gallagher on the 25th January were covered by cheque No. 3354, as already pointed out to you in letter of the 30th April. Two accounts were paid by cheque 3354, viz. one for \$50.50 for desks and the account for \$9.99 for kitchen furnishings making a total of \$60.49.
