All that certain tract of land situate at the mouth of the Franklin Creek or River on the Easterly side of the Alberni Canal, Barclay District, Vancouver Island, Previous of British Columbia and known as the Iwachis Indian Reserve, No. 3 of the Seehaht Band of Indiano, containing twenty-six acres be the same more or less X as shown on a plan of survey dated 1883 made by Ashdown H. Green and of record in the Department of Indian Affairs and which may be described as a tract or tracts of land bounded on the West by the Alberni Canal, on the South by a line drawn from a post planted on the shore of the said canal East five hundred and five feet and on the East by a line drawn North from the Easterly end of the said line crossing the Franklin Creek one thousand nine hundred and eighty feet to a post phanted on the said Alberni Canal. Provided, and it is hereby expressly declared that this patent is issued and accepted without recourse against the Dominion Government in case of the establishment of any claim on the part of or under the Province of British Columbia to the said land or any interest therein.
