- Q. That would be facing in a southerly direction?
- A. Yes. The car was touched on the rear left side.
- Q. What was the number of the car?
- A. I don't know the number. Which one?
- Q. The Chev Car.
- A. I don't know the number. (witness looks at pocket book)

- Q. That car was parked outside of what house?
- A. 89
- Q. I ask you to examine exhibit "2" a map of Brussels, south, and place a circle at the approximate place where 89 is and put number one inside the circle.
(witness examines map, marks circle and figure one)
(witness points out Avenue Brugmann)
- Q. When you arrived at the scene of the accident did you fix the time?
- A. No.
- Q. How many people did you see there?
- A. I saw one soldier facing East., and one soldier with a body behind him.
- Q. Did you see any civilians when you arrived there?
- A. I saw two or three civilians near the car, and the owner of the chevrolet car.
- Q. What was the owner's name?
- A. Mr. DEMYTTENAERE DESIRE
- Q. You referred to a body. Where did you see the body?
- A. I saw the body about five metres from the car just behind the soldier. D.L.R.
