Dear Sir:-

I have been advised by the District Forester that apparently a trespass has occurred on Wai-Waikum Indian Reserve, Squamish River, and that approximately 665 lin. ft. of fir piling have been cut and removed and approximately 2551 f.b.m. butts have been left on the area.

I am also informed that A. Munro, G. Munro and R. Lasser of Squamish, B. C. have been operating in that vicinity, and it is assumed that this material was cut by them.

Kindly investigate this alleged trespass.
