- I, on the same day did affix to the said post a notice to preempt about 80 acres bounded by a line commencing at this post thence East 30 chains to a point on the foreshore of Saanich Inley, thence North westerly following the shoreline about 58 chains, thence South 40 chains to the point of commencement. July 7th, 1911. (Sg (Sgd) R.EGosnell.

 That the land is not timber land within the meaning of the Act.

My application to record is not made in trust for or on behalf of, or in collusion with any otherperson or persons, but honestly on my own behalf for settlement and or cupation, for agricultural purposes; and I also declare that I am duly qualified under the said Act to record the said land; and I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the "Canada Evidence Act, 1893."
