LECTURE 1.

- 1.—State the case for England in the controversy with her American colonies in the 18th century, and compare the situation then existing with that of to-day.
- 2.—Outline very briefly the causes leading to the grant of self-government to the greater colonies.
- 3.—On what grounds do you justify, or deprecate, the policy of Imperial Expansion of the last twenty-five years.

LECTURE 2.

- 1.—Explain the general scheme of colonial government now established in the Empire, indicating the different degrees of Colonial autonomy.
- 2.—Shew the points of similarity and of dissimilarity offered by Canada and Australia in their connection with the Empire and the outside world.
