The bulk arrive in Southern Ontario about the end of October and remain until the ice breaks up in the spring.

48 Barrow's Golden-eye.

(Clangula islandica.)

An occasional visitor in winter.

GENUS CHARITONETTA.

49. Buffle-headed Duck.

(Charitonetta albeola.)

Common spring and autumn visitor throughout the Province, breeding at some points in Southern Ontario and probably doing so regularly in the more northern portions.

They arrive as soon as the ice goes out in spring and remain in the autumn until their haunts are frozen over.

GENUS HARELDA.

50. Long-tailed Duck.

(Harelda hyemalis.)

A very abundant winter resident, arriving about the beginning of November and departing at the end of April.

GENUS HISTRIONICUS.

51. Harlequin Duck

(Histrionicus histrionicus.)

A very rare visitor.

GENUS SOMATERIA.

SUBGENUS SOMATERIA.

52. American Eider.

(Somateria dresseri.)

An occasional winter visitor, all the specimens of this duck that have been taken here are in immature plumage so far as I have been able to learn.

SUBGENUS ERIONETTA.

53. King Eider.

(Somateria spectabilis.)

Occurring more frequently than the last, but still only an occasional winter visitor.
