- 3.—Ditto of Cash received by Ditto Ditto for Duties on Wines, under the Provincial Act of the 33d, George 3d.
- 4.—Ditto of Cash received by Ditto Ditto for Ditto, on Sundry Goods, Wares and Merchandises, and Licences, under the Provincial Acts of 35th, George 3d, Cap. 8 and 9.
- 5.—Ditto of Cash received by Ditto Ditto for Licences for Billiard Tables, and duties on manufactured Tobacco and Snuff, under the Provincial Acts of the 41st, George 3d, Cap. 13 and 14. No. 6.
