

*Resolv'd*, That it appears to this House, from the Report of the Committee, that in the Course of their Examination of the Public Accounts, many Difficulties arose in stating them, owing to the several Offices making up their Accounts at different Periods, that therefore it be humbly request-ed of His Excellency the Governor, that the several Officers of Government may be directed to make up their respective Accounts to a certain Day in each Year.

*Resolv'd*, That an Address be presented to his Excellency the Governor setting forth, that on examining the Public Accounts, this House find many Things respecting the Revenues of the Province, which call for immediate Relief, and to request that his Excellency will be pleased to take such Measures as may tend to a Redress thereof.

*Order'd*, That Mr. Butler, Mr. Hinsbelwood, and Mr. Burbidge, do prepare an Address accordingly.
