

Another point which I think should be investigated is the educational value of music in creating alert-ness of mind and in aiding general mental development. Some preliminary investigations have already been made which tend to show that children who had taken music for a reasonable length of time averaged higher in their school standing than those cildren who had not. If further investigation bears this out, this will furnish an additional very strong argument for including musical instrumental instruction in the schools of our country."


