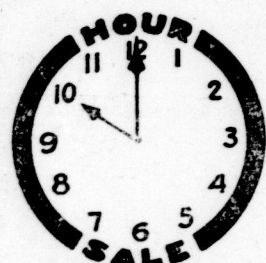

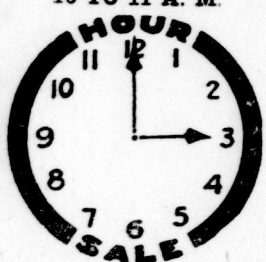

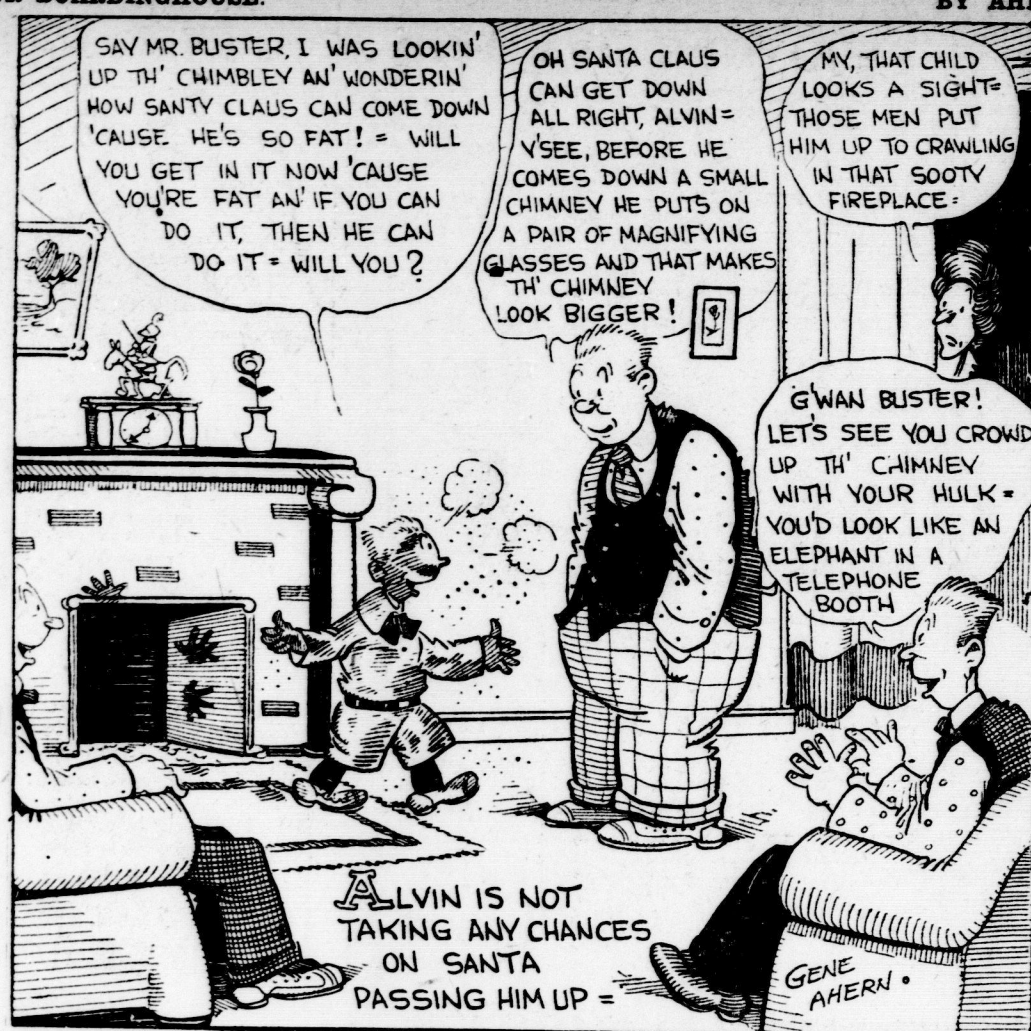

STRATFORD MAN STRUCK BY TRAIN

Fred Adams Very Seriously Injured, But May Recover.

[Special to London Advertiser.]
STRATFORD, Dec. 22.—Struck by a Grand Trunk engine attached to train No. 32 from Sarnia about 7:50 this morning, Fred Adams, 187 St. David street, was taken to the General Hospital in a precarious condition, suffering from severe flesh wounds of the face and head, and possibly a broken jaw and fractured skull.

Following an examination this afternoon it was stated that while the injured man was badly hurt, he would probably recover. The train was in charge of Engineer Henderson and Conductor Murphy of Sarnia, and was not traveling fast.

Mr. Adams is quite deaf, and this, together with the fact that he was muffled up from the cold, are possibly reasons why he did not hear the train. He is 49 years of age, and a native of London, England. He was on his way to York.

Death came suddenly today to Mrs. Elizabeth McAlister, mother of Mrs. (Col.) J. L. Youngs, aged 87 years. She was a native of Downie.

PROTEST WAGES CARPENTERS GET

Labor Men Claim Contractors Make Most of Depression.

BRANTFORD, Dec. 22.—Protest has been made by the local trades and labor council against the paying of non-union wages to carpenters by local construction firms. For some time 70 cents an hour has been paid, and it is averred that contractors are paying only what they are forced to during the period of depression.

lature. This announcement was made today, following a meeting of the cabinet. Nominations will take place 11 days earlier. The Russell by-election is still held in abeyance.



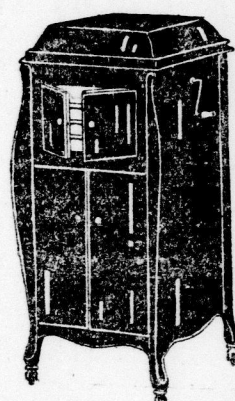

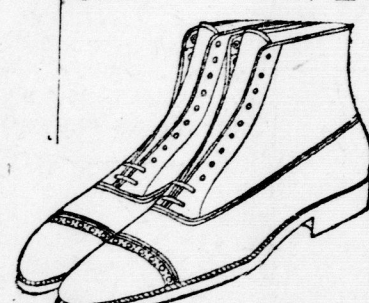

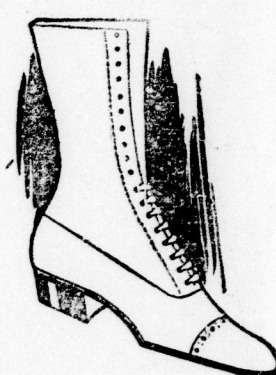
