St. John's, Nfld., Oct. 4.—The B'remain fur steamer Stord, from Hudson bay, has arrived here. She reports that the winter is rapidly setting in and that an ice pack blocked Hudson's strait on August 12. There had been frequent snow storms before September 8. The temperature at that time was never above 35 degrees Fahrenheit. The Canadian cruiser Neptune was sighted on September 10, proceeding west through the straits. The captain of the Stord expressed doubts that the steamer Gauss would be able to get through the straits this year.
