

### TIP BOOTLEGGERS REGARDING RAIDS

Men Foisted on Department, Declares Toronto Official

### DISCREDIT ENFORCEMENT

Deep Laid Plans to Circulate Harmful Propaganda

TORONTO, April 28.—(Canadian Press Dispatch).—The worries and vicissitudes of an officer in charge of enforcing the O. T. A. were told to-day to the public accounts committee of the Legislature by E. D. L. Hammond, who had charge of the enforcement of the Act in Toronto.

It was a long narration of an operator and the operator under him proving himself unworthy of the confidence placed in him. Mr. Hammond expressed his opinion that there had been deep laid plans and propaganda by bootleggers to discredit the enforcement of the Act.

One of the methods followed by bootleggers was to foist on the department men as employees who would tip the bootleggers off as to when a raid was to be made.

### KANSAS MINERS DEFEY THE INDUSTRIAL BOARD

TOPEKA, Kas., April 28.—Kansas miners would not go to work under any order made by the Kansas Industrial court, even though the wage scale may be higher than any ever in effect. George L. Peck, provincial president of district 14, United Mine Workers of America, testified in the industrial court's hearing on the coal mine strike here to-day. When the hearing was adjourned at noon the court stated no further action would be taken at present.

### ENGLISH SHOULD BE NATIONAL LANGUAGE

Bishop Brewing Advises Boys and Girls to Learn French Also.

TORONTO, April 28.—Though English should be the main language of the Canadian nation, yet it was wise that English-speaking people should have their boys and girls learn to speak French also, was the advice given by Bishop Willard Brewing of the Reformed Episcopal Church to 200 members of the Orange luncheon club at the King Edward Hotel to-day.

"While all our young people should be able to speak English, I want to urge on you that our boys and girls should also be able to speak French, as a matter of expediency and of pleasure and of culture, a means of communication between us and the people in our adjoining province, with whom we have to live and deal, whether we like it or not."

Canadian money should be spent in constructive work rather than sterile or destructive effort, he said. Mary Pickford's income was greater than the running expenses of the 55 Presbyterian churches in San Francisco and Oakland. I am not grumbling—I hope she enjoys her money, but in the face of the world's need I ask you is that a fair distribution of wealth?

He appealed for a sense of service to be cultivated and for the young men to be sent out not to make money, but to serve their fellow men.

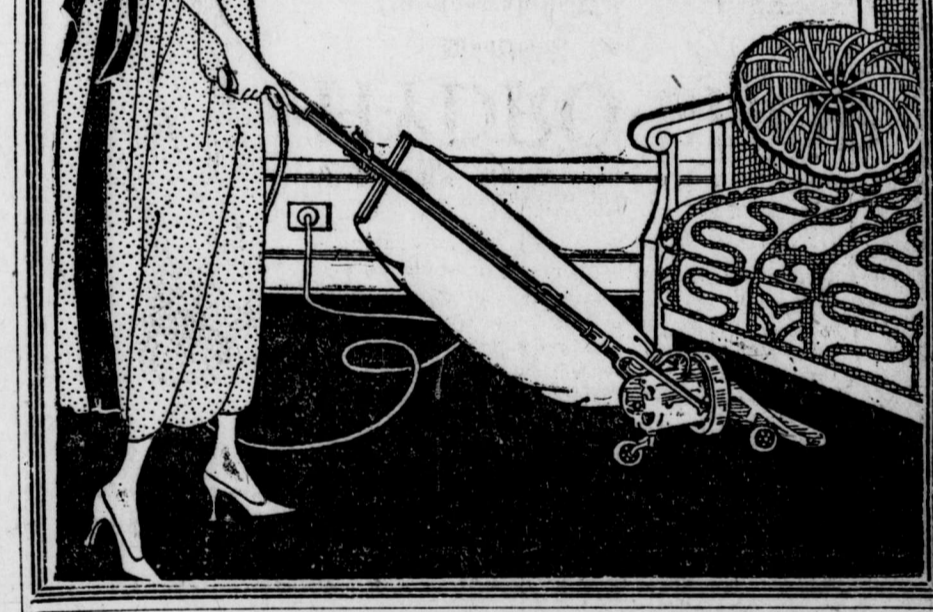

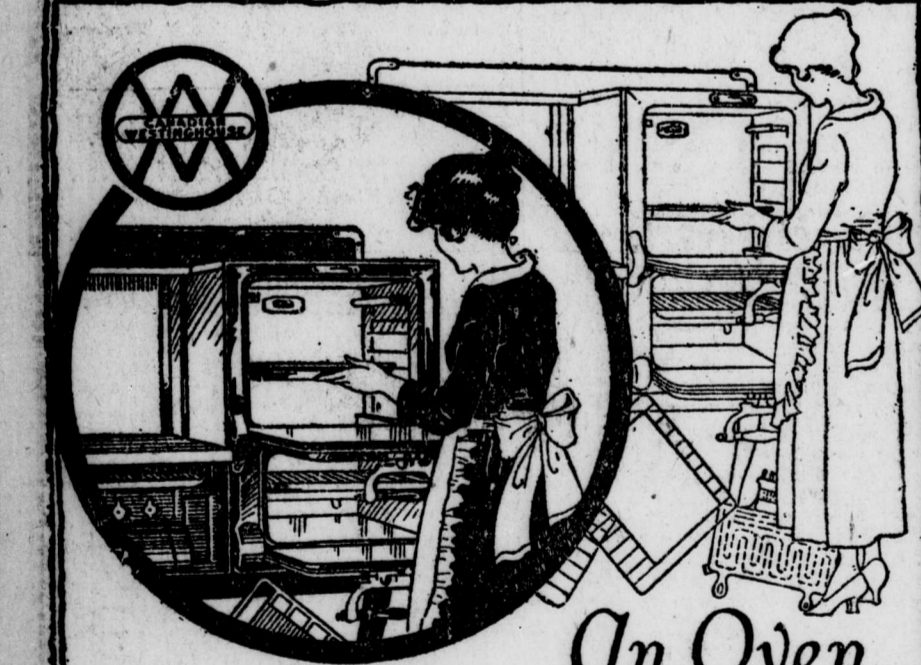
