At the annual Convocation of the Western University, London, on Thus-day, degrees were conferred on twentyday, degrees were conferred on twenty-one persons and many scholarships and prizes awarded to successful students. Addresses were made by Ven. Archdea-con Cody, of Toronto, and by the Chân-celler of the University, Hon. W. J. Roche, ot Ottawa, Minister of the In-terior One of the graduating class, Mr. F. H. Curran, has won one of the best fellowships at Cornell University, where he will pursue his studies next year; while Miss A. D. Turville will spend three months at Ottawa as the winner of the Canadian History Research Schöfar-ship. ship.

ship. In spite of the war great progress is being made by the Western University. A two hundred acre site has been pur-chased for new buildings, which is un-excelled by any university in eastern Canada; a large legacy has been be-queathed, the Government and city grants have been increased, the faculties have been greatly strengthened, the Libraries and laboratories wonderfully improved and the Medical School has received a higher rating which makes it the equal of nearly all of the better in-stitutions. stitutions.

The latest addition to the faculty is that of Professor W. Sherwood Fox, Ph. D., a former Canadian, now of Princeton University, one of the best classical scholars of the United States. He is an author of splendid repute and an excell-ent teacher. It is expected that two or ent teacher. It is expected that two or three other professors of similar standing will be exgaged during the next few weeks, all of whom will be on a par with the best men in the other universities thus assuring students that they can nov receive in this Western Ontario Univer-sitva training of the very highest kind to be obtained anywhere,



McCallum ments made to the Ontario Temperance Act, the principal addition being to the effect that the local inspector is given power to place al. parties addicted to the use of intoxicating beverages on the restricted list. In addition to this as soon as any person has been so prohibited the inspector may notify all express comparies or other common carriers in the community that further deliveries will be liable to prosecution, and the inspector is given full power to place any purties he may see fit on the restricted list.
