

The genus is placed by Mr. Ashmead in the Ichneumonini, and has the basal third of the petiole flattened, wider than thick dorso-ventrally, and the scutellum margined to beyond the middle.

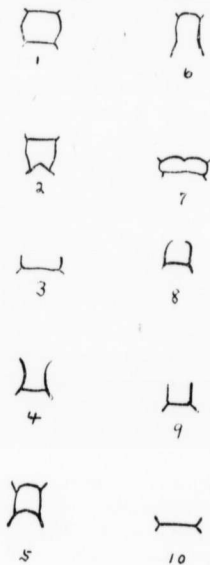
