
15. Duration of Basic Language Training

Your period on training depends upon the level to be attained.

| Levels | Authorized Maximum Duration |
|---------------|------------------------------------|
| "A" | up to 1,000 hours of training |
| "B" | up to 1,300 hours of training |
| "C" | up to 1,860 hours of training |

The steps to be followed for the calculation of your maximum training period will be:

- a) identify the level of the target profile;
- b) establish the "authorized maximum duration" for that level (see above);
- c) subtract the total accountable basic language training taken since January 1, 1974, from the time established in step b.

All basic language training provided to you within working hours after January 1, 1974, will be taken into consideration.

16. Failure in Training

If you do not meet the required proficiency of your group and level, having been notified of this requirement, the following options are open to the Department:

- a) you may be allowed to remain in your group and level while unilingual;
- b) if you are a recruit, and fail to meet the required proficiency of your occupational group and level, the Department may transfer you to a vacant, regular position within the non-rotational service, which is at the same or equivalent group or level and for which you are qualified in all respects.
