BUILDINGS, INSTALLATIONS AND INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BUNDESWEHR AT CFB SHILO

I—*Buildings and portions thereof which will be made available to the Bundeswehr at CFB Shilo by Canada are*

1. *for exclusive use*
 - a. Q7, Q8, Q9, Q10, Q11, Q12, Q13, Q14, Q15, Q16, Q17, Q18, Q19, Q20 and Q21
 - b. Building L104—all
 - c. Building HP3—9 rooms, one 8 bed ward and one washroom
 - d. Base Headquarters Buildings—3 offices
 - e. Building A13—all
2. *for use during the training period from March through November*
 - a. Officers Quarters—10 rooms
 - b. Building D1—3 offices and 4 detention cells to accommodate the German Military Police
 - c. Mess Hall—L106—all
 - d. NCO Quarters—20 rooms.
3. The costs of the general overhaul and modification of the buildings mentioned above that is carried out subsequent to 15 June, 1973 requested by the Bundeswehr shall be borne by the Federal Ministry of Defence.

II—*New Structures to be constructed by Canada for the exclusive use of the Bundeswehr are*

1.
 - a. one 7-bay vehicle washdown facility
 - b. one vehicle storage building (approximate size—4,000 square meters)
 - c. one 10-bay maintenance/repair workshop
 - d. a concrete hardstanding in addition to the other buildings or facilities (approximate size—6,000 square meters); and
 - e. an ammunition storage area having 12 storage points and an overall storage capacity for 2,300 tons of ammunition. This storage area will be constructed adjacent to the existing Canadian ammunition storage complex.
2. All necessary services and utilities, for example, water, sewerage, drainage, fire protection, fencing, electrical, gas, heating, interior lighting and roads, etc., shall be provided for these new structures, as specified by the Federal Ministry of Defence.
