The Department of External Affairs reminds Canadian citizens who have claims for restoration and rehabilitation of their property situated in Hungary, Roumania or Finland that, in order to avoid any risk of forfeiting their rights under Treaties of Peace with these countries, a formal claim must be filed with these respective Governments not later than September 19, 1948. Claimants should communicate without delay with the Department of External Affairs, Ottawa, for information on the procedure to be followed. Claimants are advised that, notwithstanding any action taken previously by them, applications for restoration of property must now be resubmitted.

In order to allow time for the transmission of such claims, all completed submissions should be sent to the Department of External Affairs before July 31, 1948.
