

interpretation of the words of another statute as they relate to this particular Bill. Whatever that interpretation may mean from a legal point of view I make no attempt to say in the course of this ruling. I simply look at the face of it and say it is an attempt to redefine what is meant by "due process of law" in the Canadian Bill of Rights *vis-à-vis* the provisions of the Bill before us. If this were to be done it would have to be done in some other way, not by a casual amendment to one clause of this particular bill. An amendment of that kind certainly goes beyond the scope of a report stage amendment and I shall therefore have to rule Motion numbered 3 out of order on procedural grounds.

And the House having proceeded to the deferred division on the motion of Mr. Stevens, seconded by Mr. Jelinek,—That Bill C-63, An Act to amend the Olympic (1976) Act, be amended in Clause 1 by striking out line 16 on page 1 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"date 1976: and, with respect to each such gold coin, prescribe that the standard weight shall be one quarter of an ounce Troy weight of gold, the millesimal fineness shall be 916, and the remedy allowance and the least current weight shall be such as are appropriate to that standard weight."

And the question being put on the motion, it was negatived on the following division:
