OBSERVANCE OF THE LORD'S DAY—Moved— "That the interests of Public Morality and the physical well-being of all classes of the community, alike render it desirable and necessary that there should be a strict and uniform observance of the Lord's Day on all the Public Works which are under the control of the Dominion Government. That in the opinion of this House, there should be an entire closing and cessation of labour on all Canals, Railways, and other Public Works which are under the control of the Dominion Government, during the twenty-four hours comprehended the Lord's Day, save and except only such services as may be of absolute and unavoidable necessity." —(<i>Mr. Christie</i>).....	727
Moved in amendment— "That the interests of Public Morality and the physical well-being of all classes of the community, require that the Lord's Day should be strictly observed by persons engaged in the Public Works under the control of the Government of Canada, so far as it is practicable to do so; That in the opinion of this House there should be a cessation of labour on the Lord's Day on Canals, Railways, and other Public Works, which are under the control of the Government of Canada, so far as in the opinion of the Government it shall be found practicable to do so."—(<i>Mr. Macdougall, East Elgin</i>).....	731
