## NORTH AMERICAN SYLVA.

## EXCÆCARIA.\*

Natural Order, EUPHORBIACEÆ. Linnæan Classification, DIECIA, MONADELPHIA.

DIECTOUS OF MONECTOUS.—Male flowers in cylindric aments, solitary, or by threes, subtended by single scales; the filament of the stamens 3-parted at the summit. Female flowers solitary or in spikes, with a calyx of scales. Capsule tricoccous.

§ GYMNANTHES. (Gymnanthes, genus. SWARTZ.)—Monœciou.s. Female flowers solitary, pedicellate, the pedicel articulated and terminated by a minute toothed calyx, its base surrounded by embracing scales. Male flowers by threes.—Trees of Tropical America, with alternate, entire, sempervirent leaves.

\* From excæcare, to blind,---the juice of the plant being so acrid as to cause blindness.
