## Four Records Are Smashed At Varsity Annual Games

### Longboat Wins Three Mile Open Race in 15.09—Meds Win School Championship—Results.

Varsity will be well able to look after herself in the sprints at the intercollegiate games in Kingston, but in the field events they have nothing unusual, with the exception of Frank of the Dents. True, of the four records that were broken at the eighth annual Varsity games yesterday, two were in the field events, but it was Jones of O.A.C., and incidentally while allowed to compete in the Varsity games he cannot pass under Varsity colors in the big event next week.

Seibert and Halbausa, who carried everything before them in the city school games last year, were again to the fore yesterday, Seibert reducing the 100-yard sprint to 10.1 seconds, with Halbausa, a close second, while in the 200-yard, Seibert fell just 1.5 of a second short of the record. Halbausa did not compete in this, but in the 400 yards both again started, and this time Seibert, who had been pushed, he could have broken any records, yet in the half-mile, if he had been pushed, he could have reduced the mark easily.

J. W. Jones of Guelph Agricultural College smashed Archibald's 16-pound hammer record all to smithereens. Archibald's record was 36 feet 9.1 inches, while Jones threw 121 feet 10.3 inches. In the discus Percy Biggs' record, which has stood for a good many years, of 99 feet, was broken by Jones, who threw 102.1 feet. Jones is from Abegweit, Nova Scotia.

Then, after the interest which had been aroused over these two finishes, had died away, along comes Jackson, the Sutherland, Indian, and Breen of the West End, which the redskin again proved victorious. The Canadian record is 15 minutes and 33 seconds.

H. C. Davis of Meds. won the J. W. Geddes medal for the high jump, while P. S. for the school championship.
