sure of prohibition must be considered an excuse for the failure of the electorate to express its opinion on the subject. That prohibitionists ought to oppose any government, or party, or candidate, who will refuse to recognize and respond to the demand of the people to at least the extent of such legislation.

Might Imitate Politics.
The friends of prohibition in every constituency are earnestly urged to take such steps as they may deem best adapted to secure the defeat of any politician, and to secure the nomination and election of candidates who can be relied upon to carry out the policy above stated.

After a Discard Voice.
