Trance is Second and Spectress Third—Results at Jamestown.

NEW YORK, Sept. 13.—The feature of the card at Gravesend to-day was the Willow Handicap, for 2-year-olds, 5½ miles, at 114 furlongs, which resulted in an easy victory for Suffragette, belonging to Jas. Roe, trainer for J. R. Keene. This is the first time the colors of Rowe have been seen here in several years. Suffragette was bought by Rowe at the Keene sale to be raced in California this winter. In today's race she jumped into the lead early and won easily. Trance was second with Spectress third. It was announced to-day that the eastern racing season will end on Nov. 4, instead of Nov. 11, as was expected.
