WHOLESALE FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

California Lemons.
California lemons of fine quality continue to come in, yesterday's arrivals selling at 42.50 per case.
Potatoes.
Potatoes vary greatly in price these days. The New Brunswick Delawares yesterday selling at \$2.25 to \$3.50 per bag, and Ontario at \$3 to \$2.25 per bag.
Hothouse produce is only being shipped very lightly and fails to satisfy the demand.

Live Stock Market

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards yesterday consisted of 108 cars—1942 cattle, 292 calves, 1206 hogs and 31 sheep and lambs.
Cattle in cattle was slow and draggy up to noon yesterday, with most butchers selling the lot lower than last week's prices, while others were 5c lower. Baby beef sold as follows: 6, 700 lbs., at \$12.50; 8, 700 lbs., at \$12.75; 10, 700 lbs., at \$13.25; 1, 740 lbs., at \$13; 2, 770 lbs., at \$11.75.
For straight carloads of butchers \$11.25 per cwt. was the best price paid, but there were a number of small lots that sold at \$11.75 to \$12.50 per cwt. Cows of all classes were steady at prices the same as last week's close, and the same may be said of bulls.
Stockers and feeders—Good to choice were slow, but prices were fairly steady; common to medium were not only slow but 2c lower in price. Milk cows and springers were without change.
Calves were strong and met a ready sale at 14c to 15c for choice, a few good calves selling as high as 16.5c lb.
Hogs—The hog market was slow and heavy. A number of carloads of hogs were really contracted for at prices steady with last week's close, namely, \$15.00 to \$17.00 for medium, \$15.25 to \$16.25 for Ben Davis appling, selling at \$3.50 per bushel.
White & Co. had a car of Rome Beauty apples, selling at \$3 per box; a car of small-sized navel oranges, 50% and 50% selling at \$2.25 per case; 28% and 25% selling at \$3 per case; a shipment of 100% navel oranges, 28% and 25% per dozen; mushrooms at \$2.50 to \$3 per basket; California head lettuce at \$5 per case; another shipment of 100% maple syrup, selling at \$1.25 per 4-lb. tin.
