



CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION.

- 1st.—That all Travelling Expenses to and from Toronto are to be paid either by the Patients or those sending them.
- 2nd.—That Three Dollars per week are to be paid by each Patient or those sending them, towards expenses of Board, Washing and Lodging, while at the Infirmary.
- 3rd.—That Municipalities or others sending Patients to the Infirmary, are required to guarantee Fifteen Dollars (the price of Five Weeks' Board); and should the Patient leave the Infirmary before the five weeks are expired, a proportionate sum will be returned.

 No charge for Medical Treatment and Medicines; and Patients are at liberty to board away from the Infirmary if they prefer it.


 DISPENSARY open to the Poor every Morning at Half-past Nine o'clock, (Sundays excepted.)
