Fielding, Minister of Finance announced in Ottawa, last evening that he had given his consent to the merger of the Bank of Hamilton and the Canadian Bank of Commerce, as, in his opinion, it was in the public interest to have this go through. He said the Bank of Hamilton was solvent but felt it was better, to ensure succes for the future, to join with the larger institution and the merger would strengthen the banking situation of the Dominion.

At the same time the united liabilities of the two banks were \$412,519,462. A later statement from these banks is now due but has not yet been published.

According to the bank statement just quoted, the total assets of the Canadian Bank of Commerce were \$383,262, 189,989 For the Bank of Hamilton the assets were \$72,381,612 and its liabilities \$62,059,584.


