SAY THAT DEATH
WAS ACCIDENTAL
Inquest Makes Recommendation Regarding Coasting on Streets.

The inquest into the death of Charles Atkinson, aged five, who was being run over by a car driven by John R. Nugent, was held last night in the court rooms by Coroner Porter. Two witnesses were present.

Atkinson, father of the little boy, said he had given him permission Monday to go to the rink to see the skating. A short time later he saw the boy collecting, and rushed over to find him in the arms of Dr. Nugent. They were the last to see the child, where it was discovered that he was dead.

The witness didn't think Richey street was a good place to slide on account of the traffic on City road.
Dr. Nugent said he was driving slowly along City road and saw no children behind the car. On examination he found that the lad's head was cut badly and the skull practically crushed. He thought death was instantaneous. The driving and light were good, and he was going along very cautiously.

Coroner Porter, in summing up the evidence, informed the jury that he had the inquest more as a warning to parents than from the thought that there had been any criminal negligence connected with this case. He also asked the jury to bring in some suggestion that would tend to make coasting safer than it was at the present time.
The jury brought in the following verdict:
"We, the jury empaneled to inquire

We do find that this is one of the unfortunate accidents where no blame can be attached to any one.
