All our party were saved, though about fifty Chinese were drowned. On the boat were Rev. R. S. and Mrs. Taylor with their four children, and Miss Dale, returning from furlough; also Rev. Mr. Walker and Miss Walker, Nurse Batstone and Miss E. Wilson, going out for the first term. These people by the narrowest margin escaped being caught in their cabins as the boat turned over soon after striking. They assisted each other up on to the high side of the boat, where they remained until rescued by sampans. until rescued by sampans.
