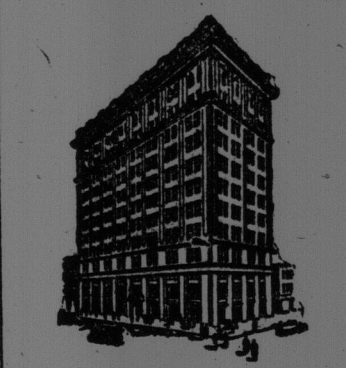

### BOLSHEVIKI.

London, May 17—It is announced that the Bolsheviks have appeared at Astara, and crossed the Persian frontier, says a despatch to the London Times from Teheran under date of May 11.

The despatch adds that the Bolsheviks said they had no quarrel with Persia, but that the British troops must be withdrawn.

Astara is a small town in the South East corner of Trans-Caucasia on the Caspian Sea.

### JAPANESE ELECTIONS.

Tokio, May 17—Returns from the elections for parliament show that the government party won 265 seats, the opposition 119 seats, the Nationalists 29, and the Independents 39. Twelve seats have not yet been decided. The government will have a substantial majority in the house.

### SOLDIERS' EDUCATION.

Quebec, May 17—The principal question discussed at the seventh conference of Canadian Universities here today was that of providing for students whose studies were interrupted by overseas service in the Canadian army. Sir Robert A. Falconer, president of the University of Toronto, submitted the report of the committee of the education of the soldiers.
