Added to this we had to endure the pain of witnessing, month after month, the failing health of our beloved President, Mrs. Murray, who was evidently overtaxing her energies by her self-forgetfulness. But we trust now by retirement, rest, and God's blessing on the means used, she may be restored to a fair measure of health and usefulness once more

Our Society has this year raised for the General W. F. M. Fund, by voluntary contribution, fees and Thank-offering Service, \$80; and by supplies of clothing, new and old, and boots, to the school at Birtle, Man., under Mr. and Miss McLaren, \$98; a falling off from last year in cash of \$39.72, and in goods of \$26.88.

Seven new members joined at Annual Meeting, so that we are again forty-six in number.
