IMPORTANT NOTICE.

At the Semi-Annual Meeting of the Governors of the College of Physicians and Surgeons, Province of Quebec, held in Montreal on the 11th May, 1892, it was decided that for the future it would not recognize Degrees or Preliminary Certificates from any Province that did not reciprocate with them. Under this decision the Preliminary Certificates from Ontario will not be accepted by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec. This decision is important to those students who intend to apply for the Quebec License, as heretofore the Ontario Preliminary Certificate has been received. The Quebec Licensing Board reciprocates with the Province of Manitoba.

The Preliminary Certificate of the Medical Councils of Nova Scotia,

New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island, will doubtless be received, as
these Provinces register Quebec Licentiates on simple payment of the
Registration Fee.

The Faculty have decided to expend the sum of two thousand dollars during the vacation in furnishing apparatus, &c., for the College, so that the coming session will find the College better equipped than ever in all that is necessary to well and thoroughly illustrate the course.
