The first one, valued at \$100.00, consists of one year's board and tuition at the College free, and is drawn at the end of the second scholastic term by those boarders who obtain an excellent note of conduct during the

The second one, valued at \$30.00, consists of one year's tuition free, and entire scholastic year. is drawn by those boarders and half-boarders whose conduct was excellent

during the whole scholastic year. Besides these two extra premiums, a first prize is awarded to each boarder, half-boarder and quarter-boarder whose conduct was excellent during the entire scholastic year, and a second one to each whose deportment was excellent during nine months.

Course of Study

Classical, Commercial and Preparatory.

Classical Course.

This course, principally imparted in French, comprises six years of study. Latin, Greek, French, English, History, High Mathematics, Literature, Rhetoric, Sciences, Philosophy, etc., are taught; all that is requisite to prepare young men for any profession, religious, ecclesiastical or liberal. Bourget College has been affiliated to Laval University, Quebec, since

1884.

French and English Preparatory Course.

This course consists of three year's study and embraces the teaching of the English and French Grammars, Geography, History, Arithmetic, Reading, Penmanship, Drawing, etc.
