Schooner at Mobile  
Word was received by Nagle and Wigmore yesterday saying that the schooner Harry A. McMillan is at Mobile from St. Croix, D. W. I. She will load a cargo of sugar for Porto, Portugal. Captain William Chapman, a native of this city is in command.

Hers Today  
The United States Shipping Board steamer Blair is due here today to load a cargo of flour for Greece.

Now a Total Loss  
Halifax, Feb. 21—Thursday's storm has completed the wreck of the schooner Dianshu which sank almost two weeks ago, between Whitman's and Mackenzie's wharves. The schooner had changed hands shortly previous to her sinking and it had been hoped to put her in commission again. The heavy seas tossed up by the fierce south-westerly gale proved too much for the schooner and she was badly torn apart. Her only remaining spar was snapped off and she is now lying across Mackenzie's wharf. Her other spar was broken at the time she sank in an effort to straighten her up and move her out of the way of other ships lying in the dock. Most of her upper structure is floating above where the battered hull is lying and it is likely that she will soon be removed.

The wreck of the Dianshu removes another veteran schooner from Nova Scotia waters. Mariners may see a nearly 60 years old. She has been repaired several times. About ten years ago when she was owned by Prince Edward Island, she was wrecked in the Bay of Fundy. She was then owned by Martin Mackinnon, coal merchant of Montague, P. E. I., and was engaged in carrying coal.

Damage by Storm  
Halifax, Feb. 20—Yesterday's storm played havoc with the shipping on the Dartmouth side. The steamer Shoba, lying at the Marine Slip wharf pulled out several of her mooring posts, broke free and collided with the wharf of the
