CHERIAULT, Lieut.-Col Hon. LEVITE, J.P. (*Madawaska.*)

Of Acadian origin. B. at St Basil, N. B. 1837. Ed. at St. Anne's College, P.Q. Unmarried. Is Lieut.-Col. of Victoria Reserve Militia. mem. of the Provl. Board of Agriculture, and Secy. of the Victoria Central Agricultural Society. Was a mem. of Ex. Council from July, 1871 to Feb., 1872, when he resigned. Represented Victoria from 1867 to g.e., 1874, when returned for the new county of Madawaska. A conservative, and in favour of separate schools. *St. Basil.*
