And provided also that no application for examination and admission of any person under this Act shall be entertained, nor shall any person be examined, sworn, admitted or enrolled as an Attorney or Solicitor under this Act, unless he shall, at least fourteen days next before the first day of the Term in which he seeks admission, have left with the Secretary of the Law Society of Upper Canada his articles and contracts of service and any assignments thereof, together with affidavits of due execution thereof, and of due service thereunder, a certificate of the person in England, Ireland or Scotland, with whom he served as an articled Clerk as aforesaid, to the effect that his moral character is good, and a certificate of his having attended the sittings of the Court or Courts during Term as hereinbefore provided.

2. This Act shall be construed as part of the said Act, and of the Act to extend the provisions thereof, passed in the last Session; and the said Acts shall be construed as if the provisions of this Act were contained therein.

3. This Act shall extend to Upper Canada only.
