The Honorable Mr. Alexander moved seconded by the Honorable Mr. Shane,

That an humble address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House, copies of all tenders and correspondence relating to the construction of the Georgian Bay Branch of the Canadian Pacific Railway, which have been received at the Department of Public Works, pursuant to public advertisement, dated the sixth day of November, calling for the same.

The question of concurrence being put thereon the same was resolved in the affirmative, and it was

Ordered, That such Members of this House as are Members of the Privy Council do wait on His Excellency the Governor General with the said Address.

The Honorable Mr. Bourinot moved, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Campbell,

That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House a copy of the Report of Mr. Perley, C. E., on the enlargement of the St. Peter's Canal.

The question of concurrence being put thereon the same was resolved in the affirmative, and it was

Ordered, That such Members of this House as are Members of the Privy Council do wait on His Excellency the Governor General with the said Address.

The Honorable Mr. Kaulback moved, seconded by the Honorable Mr Bournet, That an humble address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House copies of all letters, petitions, or other papers or correspondence relative, or in connection with appointments to, and resignations or dismissals from office, and the appointment of anccessors in the County of Lunenburg, Nova Scotia, since the 1st October, 1873.

The question of concurrence being put thereon, the same was resolved in the affirmative, and it was

Ordered, That such Members of this House as are Members of the Privy Council do wait on His Excellency the Governor General with the said Address.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Scott, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), it was

Ordered, That the Honorable Mr. Wilmot be added to the Select Committee appointed to examine and report upon the Contingent Accounts of the Senate for the present Session.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Scott, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), it was

Resolved, That the Honorable Mr. Wilmot be relieved from further attendance on the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons on the Printing of Parliament, and that the Honorable Mr. Fabre be appointed in his stead.

Ordered, That the foregoing Resolution be communicated to the House of Commons by one of the Masters in Chancery.

The Honorable Mr. Scott presented to the House a Bill intituled "An Act to "amend 'The Interpretation Act,' as respects the Printing and Distribution of the "Statutes, and the territorial application of Acts amending previous Acts."

The said Bill was read for the first time.

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a second time on Friday next.

Then, on motion of the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), seconded by the Honorable Mr. Scott,

The House adjourned.
