An Act to enable the Municipal Council of the Town of Cornwall to appropriate the surplus of certain monies raised for making a Macadamized Road.

HEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Cornwall, deeming it Preamle greatly for the advantage of the Town that a Macadamized Road should be constructed therefrom to the rear of the Township of Roxborough, and believing that the Townships of Cornwall and Roxborough 5 would take equal shares with the said Town in the undertaking, proposed a By-law for raising for the said Town on the credit of the Consolidated Municipal Loan Fund, a sum not exceeding three thousand pounds currency, to be applied to the purpose of assisting in the construction of the said Road or any portion thereof not less than four miles in length, reckening from 10 the said Town, which By-law after being submitted to a special meeting of the inhabitants of the said Town, in the manner by law provided, was almost unanimously approved by them and was finally passed on the 30th day of November, 1853, and the sum of three thousand pounds was raised under the authority thereof; And whereas an incorporated Company was 15 formed under the Act in that behalf provided for the purpose of making the said Road, and the said Town Council subscribed for and hold stock therein in behalf of the said Town, and the said Road has been constructed and made as far as Eameres Corners, a distance of upwards of four miles from the said Town, and is now in such a state of forwardness as that it 20 must be completed so far by the first day of May, 1856; And whereas the Township Councils of the said Townships of Cornwall and Roxborough have refused to assist in constructing the said Road beyond Eamers Corners. and it is not for the advantage of the said Town to assist in making it beyond that point without the co-operation of the said Townships, and 25 there will remain in the Bank of Upper Canada in which the sum raised under the said By-law is deposited, a balance of the said sum after paying for the stock of the said Company subscribed for by the said Town. and all other expenses lawfully incurred by it under the said By-law, and the said Council of the said Town have prayed to be empowered to 30 apply such balance for the purpose of making certain improvements in the said Town, which prayer it is expedient to grant; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Any balance which may remain of the said sum of three thousand Balance of the pounds, after paying up the stock of the Road Company aforesaid, sub-money raised 35 scribed for by the said Town Council of Cornwall, and any other expenses for a certain Road, to apincurred by the said Town Council in respect of the said Road, shall be plied to imapplied by the said Council towards the improvement of Water Street provements from the Bridge over the Canal eastward to Pitt Street, and Pitt Street within the from Water Street to the room of the said Town, with stone or the Town. from Water Street to the rear of the said Town, with stone or other 40 imperishable materials; and the said balance shall be paid over by the Bank of Upper Canada, to the Treasurer of the said Town, and shall
