

and thinking it better to leave his good will
His Honour gave the Claimant £10 -
expressed to be for good conduct, and His
Honour considers the Claim not only -
absolutely extinguished but amply paid
by the £10. which was certainly more
than any good he could do, though
perhaps a couple in compensation to the
amount he might have made.

With regard to the second Claim
which is apparently strengthened by
copy of a letter from Mr. McRay, the
claimant insisted on going after a Band
of Deer, who were disappointed in
seeing the Governor, and here His Honour
considers a payment of £50 would be
ample
