Referring to your letters of the 5th April and 18th July last, I would not think it advisable that a reserve be set apart in a territory under license. Under our laws, regulations and usage, no limitation of a definite number of years may be placed, as suggested, for the licensee to take the timber off, since a license holder complying with the regulations has a right to yearly renewal of his license.
