In reply to your letter of the 17th instant, in regard to permission for Indians to cut and sell railway ties, logs and square timber. I have to request you to be good enough to submit the names of the applicants for permits, and the quantity and kind of timber each applicant is desirous to take out, and to report fully as to whether you would recommend the granting of the permits and on what terms and conditions.
