Camp Borden	1-8-45		<p>0800 hours, fog. At 1315 hours, ceiling unlimited, visibility 3/4 miles, with haze. Flying was washed in at 1330 hours, dual flying only, and washed out at 1700 hours. Twilight flying washed in at 1830 and washed out at 2130 hours. Total flying 79:30 hours.</p> <p>Once again a hobbycraft instructors course was held in the army area. Major Moore invited us to send two representatives from our hobby groups. Mr. Hutchinson of the Auxiliary War Services was conducting the course. It was broken up into leathercraft, plastics, woodcarving and woodturning. As we were so far advanced on this station, most of our men were used as instructors. The course on plastics is being held in our plastics shop with L.A.C's Hurd and Van Luven acting as instructors. This course will continue for a week and it is hoped that it will be favourably attended.</p>
