employes in like meeting shall designate some other person to represent
them. It is therefore highly important that the employes choose with
the utmost care the one of their number in whom they have most confidence.

In order that the greatest freedom may be given the men in making their selection, it is bereby expressly provided that Superintendents and Fit Bosses shall not attend, and that none other than wage corners in the Company's employ shall be entitled to be present and vote in the choice of a representative.

The meeting is free to choose its own Chairman, whose duty it will be to see that the purpose for which the meeting is called is duly carried out and to notify the numegement in writing of the name of the person selected as representative.
