Mr. Speakman (p. 350) discussed the question but made no definite suggestion for legislation.

Mr. Bury (p. 383) is not enthusiastic about rural credits. Rural credits are only a necessary evil. No country gets rich by borrowing. Countries grow by thrift. The best brains of this House ought to be directed to how the men may live without borrowing rather than to make borrowing easier.
