Secretary General League of Nations transmits to Governments Members League on behalf of Committee Thirteen following text adopted by that Committee on April 9th, 1936:-

The Committee of Thirteen, having taken cognisance of the communications addressed by the Ethiopian and Italian Governments to the Secretary General on the subject of various failures to comply with International Agreements on the conduct of war and expressing the emotion which these infractions have caused to public opinion, addresses an urgent appeal to both belligerents inviting them to take all the necessary steps to prevent such failures to comply with the said Conventions and of the principles of International law. The Committee hopes to receive from the Powers to whom it addresses this appeal such assurance as will allay the emotion to which it has given expression.

Committee Thirteen instructed by Council League follow Italo Ethiopian conflict met April eighth, Chairman Madariaga, Spain, who presented report explaining action taken sincd last meeting.
