With reference to the subject of medical attendance in the Naas Agency, I beg to say that the Department will be glad to receive a report from you bearing on the question of the appointment of Dr. Seymour Traynor, as medical officer to the Indians of Kitsumkalum and Kitselas. I enclose herewith for your information in the matter copy of a letter, of the 13th February, which the Department received from Mr. Perry. Mr. Perry is being informed that Dr. Ardagh has been instructed to render accounts for any attendance which he may furnish to Indians. The Agent has also been told that Dr. Traynor may submit accounts and that the question of the latter's appointment on salary will be dealt with later.
