Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, and in reply I beg to say that in letter of the 27th instant authority was given you for the sub-letting of the contract at the Kootenay Industrial School.

The plumbing and heating may also be sub-let to Mr. McBride, as requested by the contractor, Mr. Wood, but the Department reserves the right to make any changes that may be deemed advisable in the heating system. As you are aware this matter is at present under consideration. This will allow Mr. Wood to proceed with the plumbing and also with portions of the heating system, as it is only the boilers that it is proposed at the present time to change.
